## Behind The News

| Within the next week, the Aluminum Company America will back a taxicab or a truck up to toors of the Office of Production Management here In Washington and unload its order books. It won't mean that the giverniment wili have taken over the aluminum company, but it will be darn close to it. And it will mean that O. P. M. will have taken over control of every pound of alumior as sheets, bars, castings, finished machined parts or pots and pans. <br> Unloaded, the order books of the company will be taken up to the offices of the priorities section of 0 . P. M. and there, in some complicated procedure not yet figured out by either the government or the com-1 pany, the experts from both will determine just who pany, the experts from both will determine just who In the allocation, airplane manufarposes, allocated sufficient aluminum for their requirements Other defense industries will get their share. If there is any left over, it will be spread out among private Industries making ice boxes, vacuum cleaners, door stops, ash trays, pots and pans, If door stops, ash trays, pots and pans. If, however, an ice box manufacturer says, "You've gotta give me so many pounds or Tll have to lay off my force," his plea will be heard and he will be given enough to keep running. But only for a time. The ice box maker will be told that he'll have to redesign his product so that hell use.other materials-other metals or even plastics. Consequently, over the long haul you may see some brand new industrial design in artisound <br> But THICK, AND IT IS <br> Bes the big idea will be to keep individual indusbusinesses, shooting up the price and creating own ity and confusion all over the country. Priorities certificates will be issued to the manufacturers who get the major consignments of aluminum. These will be graded under a code beginning with AA , going through $\mathrm{A}-1, \mathrm{~A}-2, \mathrm{~A}-1-\mathrm{a}, \mathrm{A}-2-\mathrm{a}$, and so on through through A-1, A-2, A-1-a, A-2-a, and so on through $\mathrm{A}-10$. Army and Navy Munitions Board will grant these certificates direct to prime contractors and first sub-contractors. The Priorittes section of O. P.
