He was the spoken conscience of the American people when that sometimes fitful and forgotten spark is stirred beyond endurance.

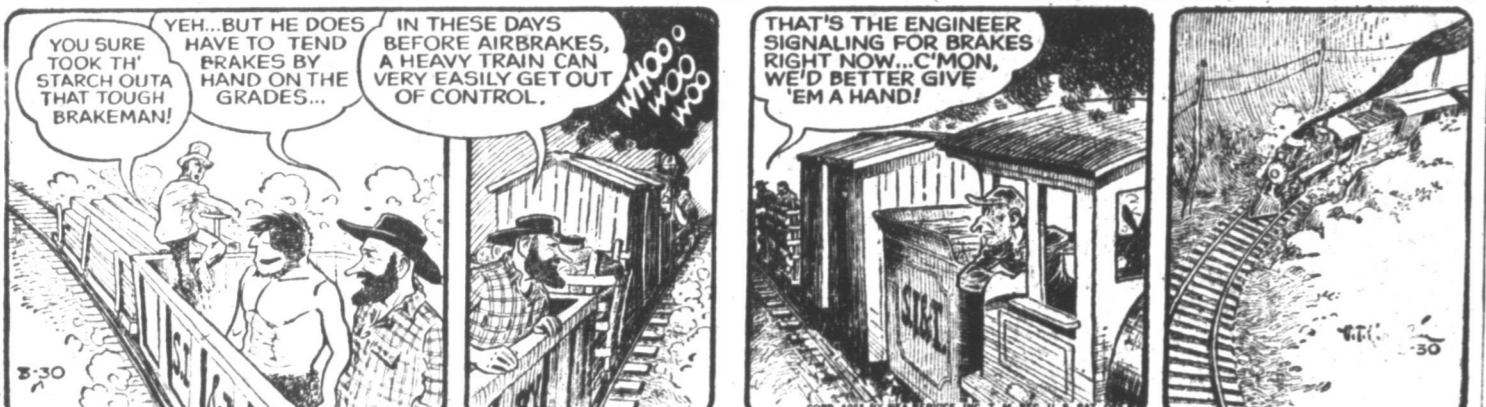
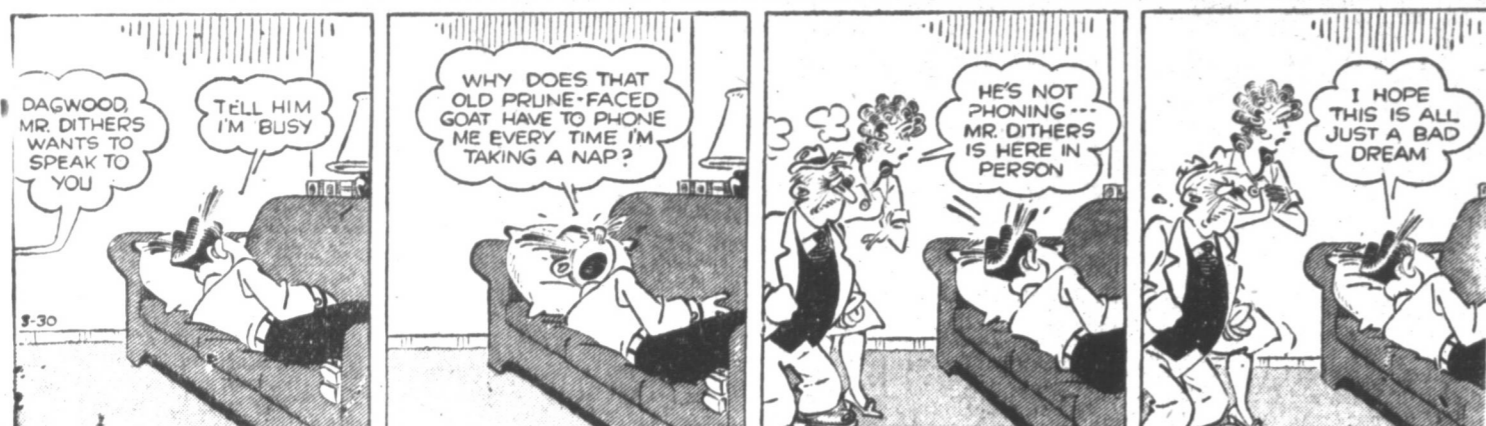
