Your Income Tax -- No. 3

How to calculate taxable value of pension or annuity.

In preparing the material suggested in the previous article, for use in your income tax return, here are some suggestions to help you remember everything.

1. This statement comes from your employer, who may use Government Form W-2 or one of his own that gives the same information.

2. "Payments for personal services" are taxable, no matter who is your employer. Besides formal salary or wages, they include commissions, bonuses, tips, gifts from anybody for whom you have done anything.

3. Dividends from stocks should be added up from your own record. "Dividends" from mutual insurance companies are not true dividends, but only a refunding of excess payments, and they are not taxable.

4. Interest receipts should be compiled from your own records. For this and the dividend item, only the gross total is needed—not itemized list.

5. Since the articles are intended principally for the moderate income groups, most readers will own government savings bonds issued since March 1, 1941.

Senate Struggles With Vote Bill

WASHINGTON, Feb. 7 (AP)—A renewed attempt by "states rights" advocates to sidetrack the administration federal war ballot bill took shape today as the senate opened its third week of see-saw debate on the question of votes for the armed forces.

Undismayed by one defeat, supporters of a house-passed bill to leave military absentee voting up to the states said they would renew their drive to make that the first order of business.

"I don't consider a tie vote conclusive on such an important issue: the issue of state voting as against federal voting," said Senator Overton (D-La.), one of the Democrats fighting alongside a group of Republicans against the administration.

If the motion will be renewed, "If they win the effect will be to shut aside the administration's war ballot bill after two weeks of debate and send the senate into immediate consideration of the 'states rights' bill.

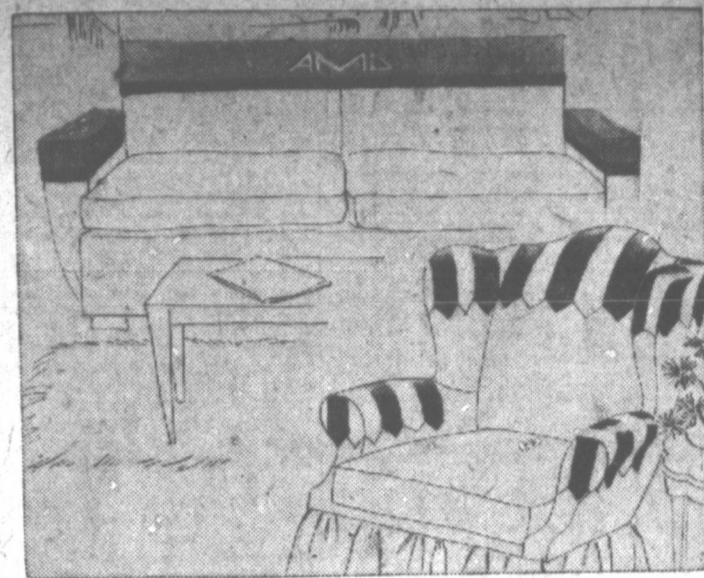

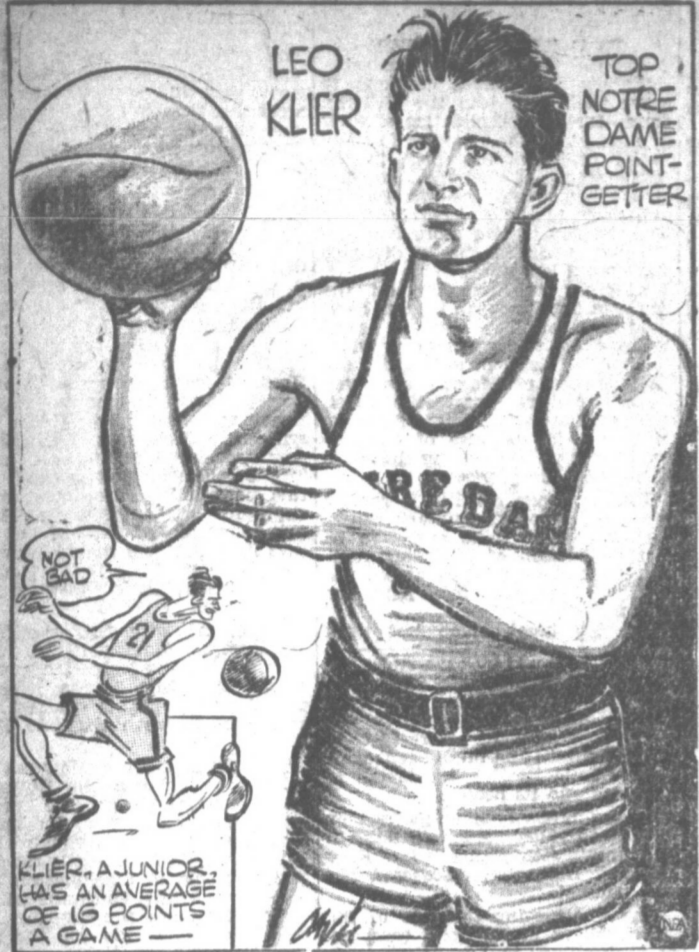

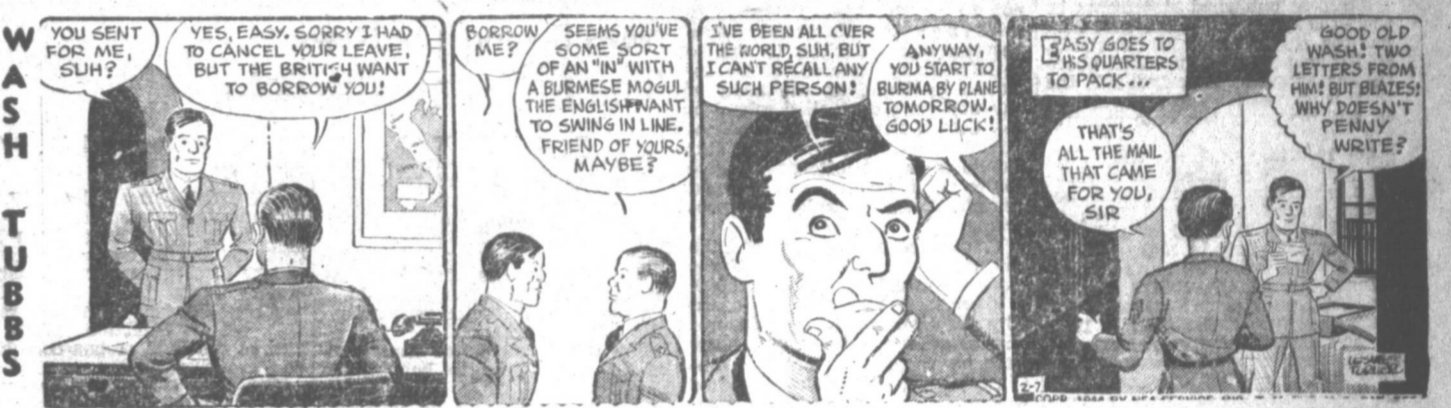
