Mr. Truman made the momentous announcement to a hurriedly summoned news conference.

He said he had only a simple statement to make but it was so imporiant he could not delay it. Then wiih a broad grin he declared: "Russia has just declared war on Japan. "That is all.
The disclosure that the Soviet Union at lasi had pitfed its enormous might alongside Britain and the United States against the Pacific ettemy had been expected.
