

Queen's Dressmaker Is First Casualty Of The Coronation

Chamber Of Commerce Head Favors Private Ownership

WASHINGTON — (NEA) — Lawrence F. Lee, past president of the U.S. Chamber of Commerce, has been one of the leading advocates of returning U.S. public lands to private ownership. His theme has been that administration of the U.S. national forests should be freed from bureaucratic control.

Since Mr. Lee is a North Carolinian and head of the Occidental Insurance Co. of that state, there has always been considerable puzzlement as to why he should be such a champion of the western livestock growers who want less federal control over their grazing rights on public lands.

Hugh B. Woodward, president of the New Mexico Game Protection Association, shed some light on this riddle in Washington recently during a speech before the North American Wildlife Conference.

"Mr. Lee is a stockholder, director and vice president of the Fernandez Co., a New Mexico corporation, which is one of the larger livestock growers of sheep and cattle in the Southwest," said Mr. Woodward. "The Fernandez Co. operates not only on patented lands but upon forest lands and other public lands."

"He is the brother of the president of the Fernandez Co., who for 28 years has been president of the New Mexico Wool Growers' Association. During those years he has earned the reputation of being the most outspoken critic and implacable foe of the U.S. Forest Service among all western livestock men."

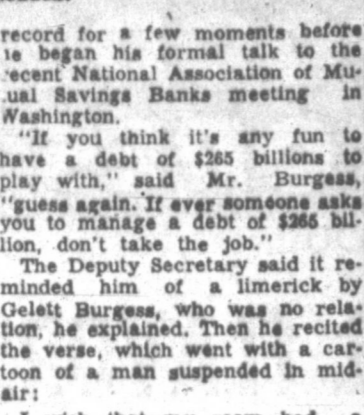
Roses for Miladuy

Ask Federal Spending Cut

TOPEKA, Kan., May 20—UP—The president of Capper Publications, a director of the National Association of Manufacturers, has called on President Eisenhower for more drastic cuts in federal spending and "handouts" so as not to break faith with the American people.

Henry S. Blake, who succeeded the late U. S. Sen. Arthur Capper as head of the Kansas publishing empire, proposed that the excess profits tax on corporations be eliminated and cuts in personal income taxes effected by June 30.

He called on Kansas' Republican Gov. Edward F. Arn to offer his cooperation to the President in an effort to cut off federal "handouts" to states and communities.

"Balancing the budget after 20 years of extravagance and unbridled spending is admittedly a tough job," Blake said, "but the American people expressed their confidence in President Eisenhower last November and I am sure he will not let them down."

Blake's written statement was released Tuesday as President Eisenhower outlined his plan for a 10 per cent reduction in personal income taxes beginning next Jan. 1,

Three Children Killed In Crash

MONTERREY, Mex., May 21—UP—Mexican authorities reported late Monday that three Mexican, Tex., children were killed when the automobile in which they were riding collided with a truck on the Reynosa highway about 30 miles east of Monterrey.

Mexican police identified the dead as Yolanda Carda Romo, eight-year-old daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Rodolfo Carda Romo; her nine-year-old brother, Rodolfo Carda Romo, and a cousin, Juan Orozco. Mr. and Mrs. Carda Romo, both 35, were injured and hospitalized at Monterrey.

Authorities reported that the accident was caused by "excessive speed" on the part of both vehicles.

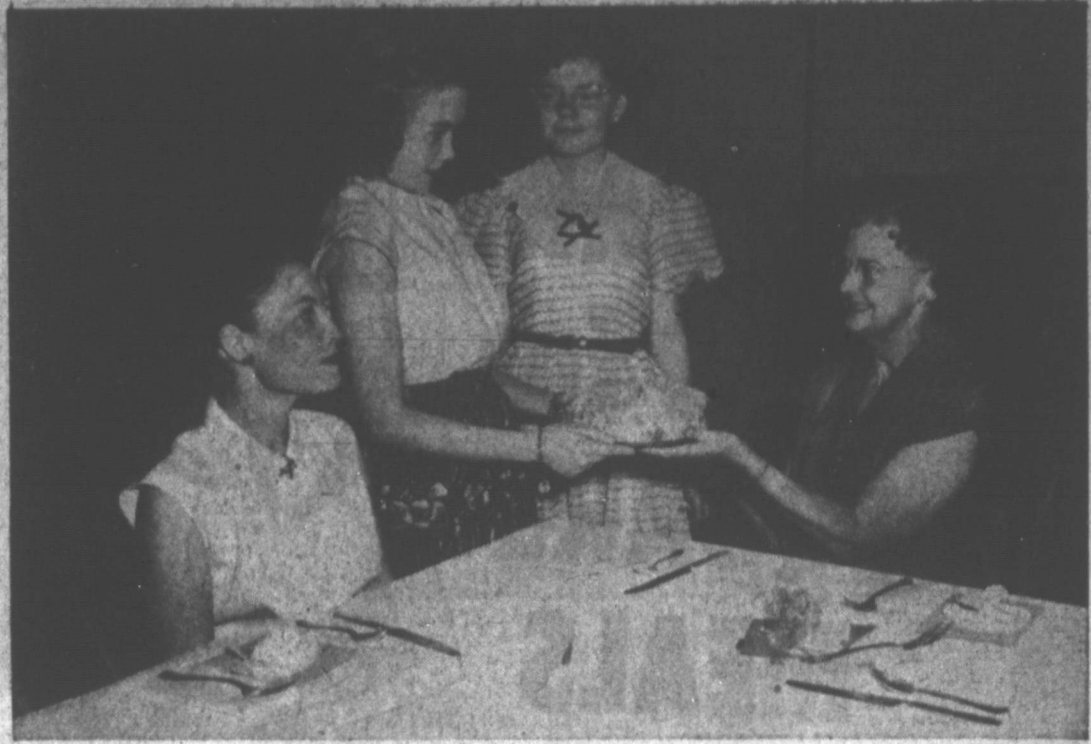
