Casualty Insurance exists to "indemnify".

Webster's defines indemnify as "to secure against loss or damage; to make restitution or compensation; to reimburse; to make good a loss".

Well aware of the reason for the existence of their reputable companies, insurance executives are ready, willing and anxious to fuffill their function . . "to reimburse, to make good a loss."

First, however, they must make sure a real honest-to-goodness loss exists so their POLICY. HOLDER'S PREMIUM MONEY will not be pald out without good cause.

Then, they must determine the extent or amount of the loss and fairly relmburse it immediately.

This is the proper function of the insurance company.
Some claimant's attorneys charge their clients a contingent fee . . an arrangement whereby the client agrees to pay the attorney from $331 / 3 \%$ to $50 \%$ of the total gross amount of any award made by a jury or court to the client. This system, which originated in England, has long since been outlawed by English courts, and a lawyer in England is now prohibited from becoming a partner in a lawsuit by taking a fee only if he wins for his client.

Whether the contingent fee system is good or bad, or whether the percentages of the awards are being abused, we don't know, but it is
