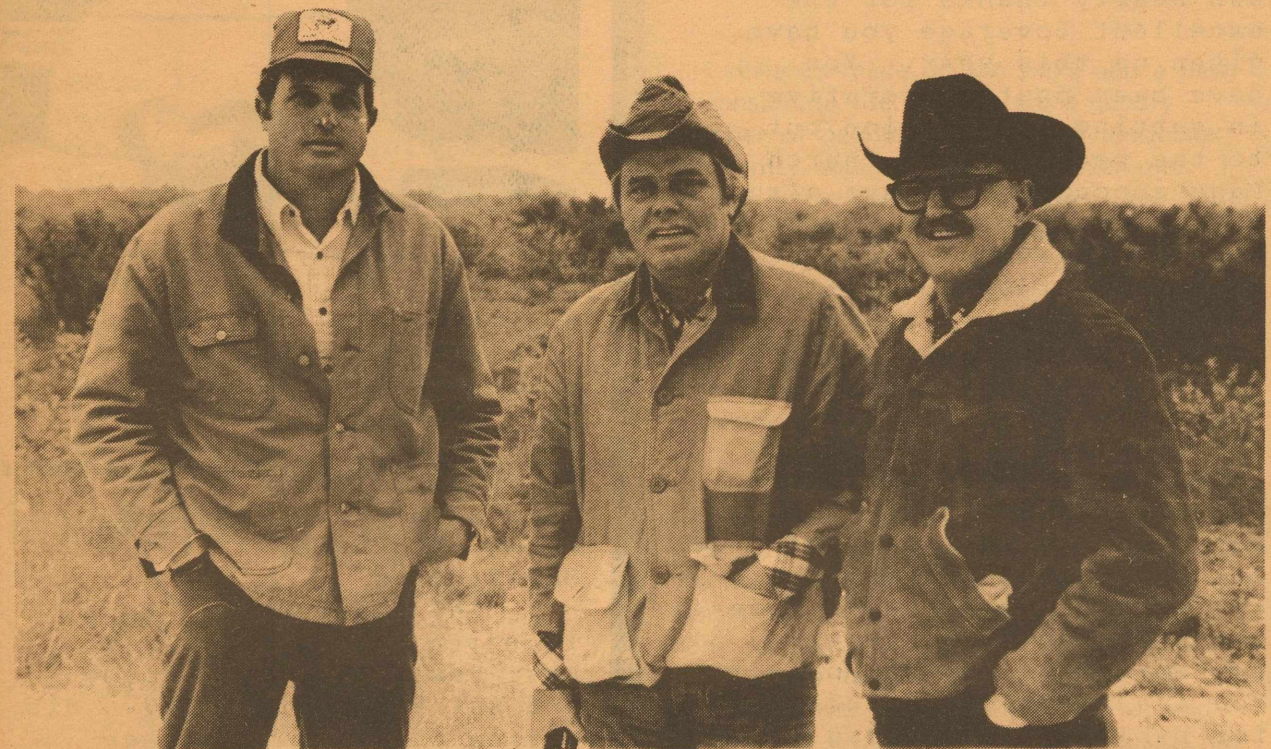

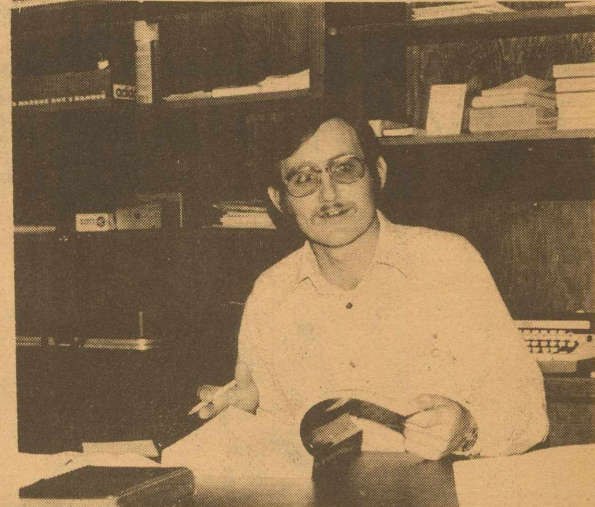
cerns of many, openly in your newspaper. Your editorial policy makes the Cavalryman a significant factor in the community.

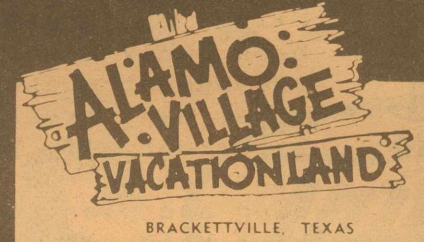

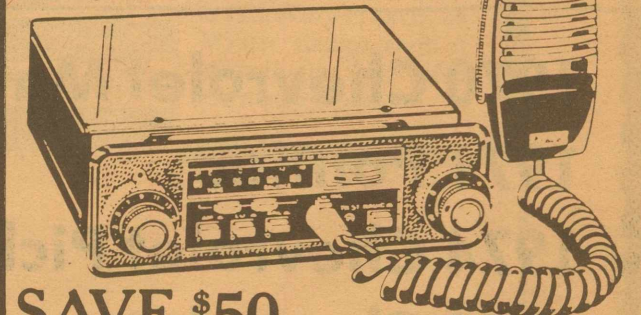

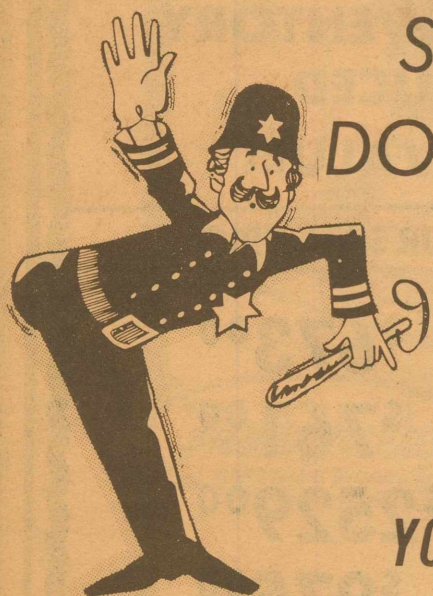

TIPS FOR GREEN THUMBS

It's almost tree planting time. In fact it is time for some trees.

If you plant trees it is better to buy B & B trees. These are trees where they are dug

with a ball of dirt on the root section and wrapped with burlap. Unless the trees have truly been badly mistreated you have the surest chance of saving the tree. Many trees can be planted bare root. If, However, any place along the line from digging and planting, the roots have been allowed to dry out chances of a growing tree are nil. So unless you know the

diggers, shippers and sellers have adequately cared for the trees it is best to refuse the temptation to buy. Trees are much cheaper when bought-bare root. But if the tree doesn't grow you've wasted good money trying for a bargain.

A hole should be dug deeply enough that the tree can be planted about the same depths as it originally grown. It is good to mix 1 part wood bark mulch to 4 parts soil to fill the hole. As soon as the hole has been filled the tree should be watered thoroughly. It is best to turn on the water in the hose and work the end of the hose down to the hollow of the hole (it will go down easily) and leave it there until the dirt around the tree is covered with water. About 3 days later 1 pint of root stimulator should be added to the water as the tree is thoroughly watered again. There after the tree should be thoroughly watered about every week. By the way-when planting a tree you'll have better trees and fewer losses if you will cut off at least the top 1/3 of the branches.

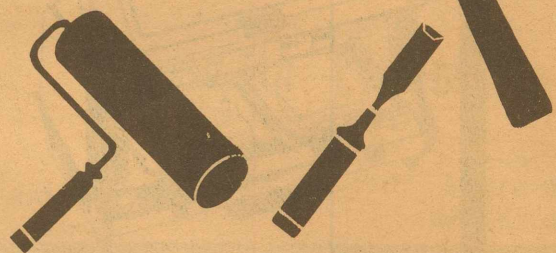
Today, the elementary children saw a play performed by the BHS speech class. "The Night the Toys Revolted" was a complete class project.
