1964, with the same period of 1963 is as follows:

There were seven fatal accidents in 1964, six in 1963 67 personal injury accidents in 1964 and 57 in 1963; accidents with property damage, 136 in 1964 and 103 in 1963; total accidents, 210 in 1964 and 166 in 1963. There were ten deaths in 1964 and six in 1963; injured in 1964, 101, in 1963, 89; amount in property damage in 1964, \$130,300 and in 1963, \$113,300.

The Internal Revenue Service Station in Austin, Texas, during 1964, received interesting figures: 32, almost five million Texans signed their tax returns to individual income taxes. These voluntary returns reported some \$15,000,000 in adjusted gross income. The biggest part of this — some \$12,237,916,000 — came from salaries and wages.

On a nationwide basis, some 99 million Americans signed tax returns, showing an adjusted gross income of \$348,708,728,000 — some 233 billion of this also came from salary and wages.

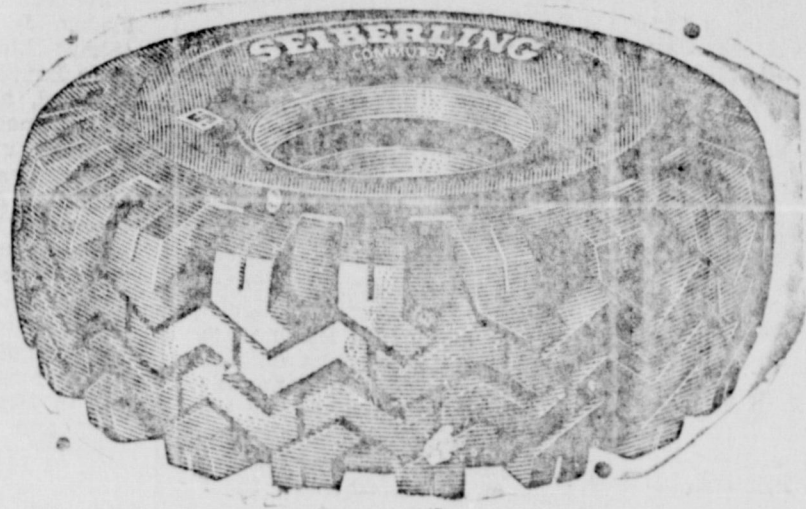

On wash day, do you play a "guess the fabric" game — because you've lost the tag that came with the garment, the one that tells what material it's made of and how to care for it? Here are some suggestions to end such confusion and avoid costly laundering errors.

Whenever you buy a garment, immediately remove the tag and label it — Mother's green shirt, Barbara's blue blouse, etc. Then be sure to save the tag. If you have a bulletin board near the washing machine, hang it there. Or, you might use a card file for garment tags. Put in dividers with the name of each

member of the family. Slip the tag from Barbara's blue blouse behind the card with her name. And you'll have no trouble finding it quickly on wash day.

If you know the fabric of a garment and how to wash it, you'll get better wear and satisfaction from it.

Some 200-man years of research have gone into the development of a new man-made breathable shoe upper material now available at many markets. "Corfam" is an entirely new material for shoe uppers, a product of intensive chemical research.

Produced in three effects — smooth, grained, napped — this material breathes through a microporous and permeable construction that absorbs and transmits normal foot moisture. While its porosity lets water vapors pass from the inside to the outside, it repels water trying to enter the shoe.

New Insurance Plan Available To NSLI Holders

A new plan of permanent GI insurance — called "modified life" — is being made available to all holders of National Service Life Insurance through the new law which re-opens NSLI for disabled veterans.

Glyndon Hague, Manager of the Veterans Administration Regional Office in Waco, said the VA plans to notify all term policyholders at the time of renewal of the opportunity to obtain "modified life" policies.

Any type of NSLI insurance, including policies already issued, may be exchanged for or converted to this new plan which will be issued at lower premium rates than the present permanent plans.

The "modified life" plan

provides a level premium through the life of the insured. However, the face value will be reduced automatically 50 per cent when the insured veteran reaches the age of 65.

At that time, Hague said, the policyholder will have the option of restoring the full amount of coverage by purchasing ordinary life insurance without a medical examination.

The new plan is offered as an inducement to NSLI term policyholders to convert before the premiums on renewable term insurance become prohibitive with advanced age, the VA Manager said.

There are still some three million NSLI term policyholders who have not converted to a permanent plan. The new policies will become available May 1, 1965.

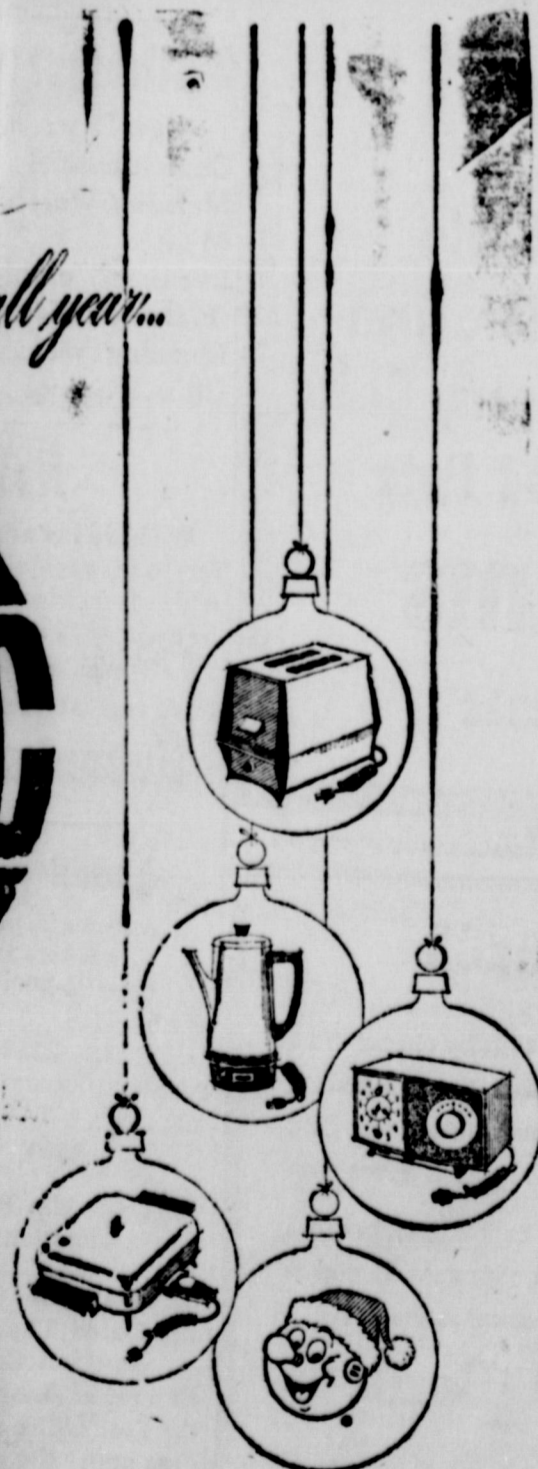
