Keeping Pace With Mitchell Women And Girls In Projects Of Club And Garden

By MISS EMMA GUNTER Home Demonstration Agent On visiting in the home of Lella June Harrell and Katha Lee Harrell, since Lella June is Food Preservation Demonstrator, with her mother, they gave in the following report showing the work they have done so far.

They have canned: Corn, 125 No. 2 cans; Peas, 42 No. 2 cans; Spinach, 43 No. 2 cans; Meats, 33 No. 2 cans; Blackberries, 15 No. 2 cans; Plums, 40 No. 2 cans; Grape Juice, 30 No. 2 cans; Jelly, 28 No. 2 cans; Miscellaneous, 4 No. 2 cans; total number of containers, 360.

They have many things left over from last year's canning that have not been included in the above list. Mrs. Harrell believes in canning for a two year period as gardens are so uncertain in this county, even though she irrigates her garden from a windmill.

A demonstration was given last week at the farm place of Mr. and Mrs. W. T. Coker, who live on one of the Lasky farms. Five women helped can 100 cans of snapped and shelled peas and green beans.

The Westbrook Girls' club met at the home of Thelma King Thursday for a lesson on hooked rugs. The girls signed up to make tufted pillow tops, chair mats and a hooked rug. New songs were practiced and games learned.

Thursday afternoon, the Conaway Girls' club met at the home of Inez Calloway with six club girls present and four visitors. The girls were also given a demonstration on making hooked rugs and mats for their bedrooms.

Friday, the Bauman Girls' club met at the church house, with six present. A demonstration on rug making and tufted bed spreads was given. The girls practiced on new songs. Square fruit jars were given to each club girl and she is to fill it with vegetables or fruit for an achievement day exhibit.

The eliminations in the girls work for Dallas Fair, trips will be made during September so that the three winning girls may be getting their things ready for the Fair that opens October 7-22.

The Girls Rally contest, July 11, when she won second prize. Since some are canning corn it might be worthwhile to give a few pointers on canning for safe keeping: It is important to use a pressure cooker and to pack the corn hot in order to insure as small a loss as possible.
