### State Will Build Quail Hatcheries

AUSTIN, March 17 — The Assistant Executive Director of the Game and Fish Commission said bids will be open March 24 for construction of the State's experimental quail hatchery at Tyler.

The Commission has authorized \$200,000 for the project which is designed to become a key factor in bobwhite restoration.

The Assistant Executive Secretary said the hatchery is expected to be ready for operation by July 1, this year, and will have an estimated annual production of 30,000 young quail. The young birds will be distributed throughout the state in areas where habitat is judged to be adequate.

The Commission tentatively has approved assignment of a staff of technicians to supervise actual rehabilitation projects.

The Assistant Executive Secretary pointed out that the downward trend in quail population in Texas paralleled the prolonged drought which devastated wide areas and also coincided with results of poor land usage. The hatchery site is four miles southeast of Tyler on the Tyler Lake Road, comprising 82½ acres of improved, fenced land, and containing two residences and a barn.

New buildings will include one major structure comprising a brooder house, hatchery room, breeder house, egg storage room and office. A utility unit will provide equipment and feed storage space and a shipping room.

There will be two units of hardening pens comprising ten runs each and one holding one unit with ten separate pens.

Entries should be addressed to Mr. Crofts or to Secretary J. M. Cooper. T. G. Caudle is general superintendent, and Ed Huestis is grounds chairman. The show will be held at the Moran Highway grounds.  
Calves born since Sept. 1, 1954, may be shown but will not be of pens of three bulls or heifers. Mixed pens or individual animals may be of pens but will not be judged. Only registered animals will be permitted in the show, Mr. Crofts said.
