But what has Mr. Rockefeller given the public in return for the code of business principlas he has taught it, in return for the havoc their enforcement has cost, in return for the hypocrisy and cynicism he has enforced? great business organization one of tha greatest the world has ever seen-a demonstration of the possibilities of combination the possib to build his organiza True, but to build his organiza uate and expand, secretly, by force, bribery and trickery a vicious business system the country at large was striving to overthrow, whose perpettation and expansion has brought us into one of the most serious public situations since the Civil War. Has that paid? He has built hospitals and colleges and endowed schools, True, and those helped have become his open apologists, by taking what the $y$ call the "large view" or the "charitable view," or by deliberatelv shunaing a consideration of the subject, quietiy not seeing in it a topic for discussion. Does it pay to have those who are entrusted with the ver sources of our intel!ectual and moral life blinded or silenced to the ethical quality of the practices of our daily life? Will it pay our colleges to put over their doors the teaching of on of our present-day moraiists, Never discuss politics or re igion if you would succeed.'
He has led a life devoted to charity and the church.
