fter considerable agitation about a cotton mill and after raising nearly the total subscription needed the people of Dublin
have adandoned the enterurise have adandoned the enterprise.
A committee visited the cotton A committee visited the cotton
mills of the state and found them paying from ten to twenty-four per cent profits, but that all of them for the first year or two allowed the profits to go into increasing the mill's facilities. This did not suit the Dublin people as they wanted the dividends to go immediately into their pockets and they gave up the thought of building a mill. It is a matter of regret that busi-
ness men so often fail to see greater profit that comes to a town and of course to them as a businsss men of a town in the amount paid out for labor every week that a manufacturing enterprising is operated. A cotton mill will pay out each year
more than its capital stock to its more than its capital stock to its employees. This money that otherwise goes to some cotton
