### Cash Prizes To Be Given In 4-H Club Lamp Show

Over 100 lamps are expected to be entered in the Eastland County 4-H Club boys and girls Electric Lamp Show to compete for the \$25.00 cash prizes at the Texas Electric Service Company's office in Eastland March 23 to April 4.

It will be a classification show and each lamp entered will receive a ribbon. The first four place lamps will receive cash prizes in the amount of 10.00, 7.50, 5.00 and 2.50.

Several lamps have been or will soon be on display at the utility company office at Gorman and Ranger as well as at the offices of the West Texas Utility Company in Cisco and Rising Star until time to bring them to Eastland for the show on the above date.

The lamps will be judged by a committee of county officials April 2 and then on April 4 all of the club boys and girls from over the county who attend the Annual Eastland County Rally Day will see all of the lamps entered and those participating will receive ribbons or cash prizes.

Lamps are expected from all of the 14 different 4-H Clubs in the county according to reports. Deadline date for entering lamps is March 21.

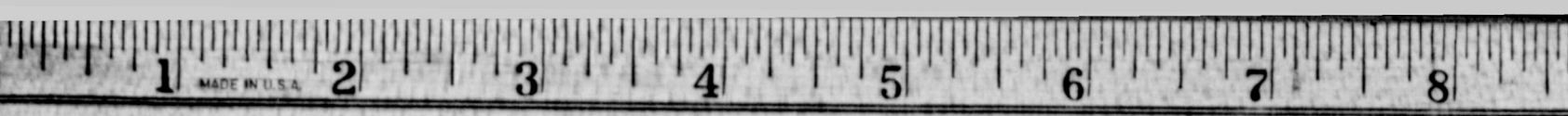

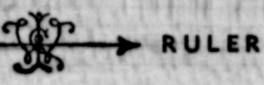

**Almond Chicken With Rice**

Chinese Chicken Almond With Rice, a delightful delicately flavored dish with chicken, celery topping, is sure to please your family. It makes an attractive "one main dish type meal" and is easily served to a crowd. Fresh or canned mushrooms may be used for making Chinese Almond Chicken.

**INGREDIENTS**  
1 cup uncooked rice  
1/2 cup sliced mushrooms (canned or fresh)  
1/2 cup almonds - blanched  
2 tablespoons salad oil, to be used 1 tablespoon at a time  
1 clove garlic, cut in half  
1 teaspoon salt  
1 cup cubed bamboo shoots (canned)  
1/2 cup thinly sliced water chestnuts (canned)  
1/2 cup thinly sliced celery  
1/2 cup sliced, cold chicken (fresh or canned)  
2 tablespoons liquid (1 tablespoon each, from bamboo shoots and water chestnut cans)

**INGREDIENTS FOR GRAVY**  
2 teaspoons cornstarch  
1/2 teaspoon sugar  
4 tablespoons water  
4 teaspoons soy sauce

**GARNISH**  
1/4 cup sliced green onion

**PREPARING THE FLUFFY WHITE RICE**-To make 3 cups fluffy rice: Put 1 cup of uncooked rice, 2 cups of cold water and 1 teaspoon of salt in a two-

quart saucepan and cover with a tight-fitting lid. Bring to a vigorous boil. Then reduce the heat as low as possible and steam for 14 minutes or until all the water is absorbed, leaving the separate rice grains with their full nutritional value. This makes very firm rice grains. (If you prefer more tender rice grains, add 1/4 cup more water and increase the slow cooking time 4 or 5 minutes.) Remove the lid, permit the rice to steam dry to the desired consistency and the grains will be separate and fluffy. Never stir rice; lift gently with a fork.

**METHOD:** Brown almonds in 1 tablespoon oil. Set aside. With table fork, mash garlic into salt in skillet. (Be sure there is a tight-fitting cover, which can be a lid.) Add 1 tablespoon oil, then add chicken, brown finely. Add 1 tablespoon oil and then bamboo shoots and water chestnuts. Brown lightly. Add liquid, drained from canned bamboo shoots and water chestnuts. Cover tightly. Cook over low heat 5 minutes. Add 1/2 of the chestnuts, celery and almonds. Just heat through. Celery and chestnuts should remain crisp. For gravy, shake up in small jar, cornstarch, salt, sugar, water and soy sauce. Stir into mixture. Cook until thickens and is smooth. Serve over dish, green onion and almonds. Serve with cooked rice. 4

The assistance provided under ACP, he pointed out, is being directed at the most needed conservation on the individual farm. The purpose is to center attention on conservation practices over and above what the farmer would carry out on his own initiative and with his own resources.

Chairman Blackwell stressed the need for farmers to make arrangements in advance for the use of such equipment as may be needed to carry out conservation practices planned for the season. Attention to this before the work season starts will give added assurance that the practices can be completed and it will give owners of equipment a chance to work out effective operating schedules, he said.
