## Dry Weather Aids In Harvesting Of Peanut Crop

Eastland County farmers, who are expected to pocket some \$4,500,000 from their 1950 peanut crop, have resumed the harvest as the fields are dry after last Thursday's rain.

Very few peanuts were marketed Friday and Saturday due to the rain, but the light rain was not expected to damage the crop.

County PMA Administrator Emmet Powell has estimated that the county has about 42,000 acres in peanuts this year. Of this acreage, 34,000 acres were allotted under the support program of \$209 per ton for medium grade peanuts.

About 8,000 to 10,000 acres were planted in excess of the quota to be sold on the peanut oil market. The price of these nuts was supported at \$170 a ton. Powell said the demand for these peanuts was good due to the unexpected high price of peanut oil.

Farm leaders have estimated that the county's overall yield will be about 30 bushels per acre, a near record yield. The harvest had proceeded with record speed until last Tuesday's rain.

Under good weather conditions, the harvest of the crop is a few weeks

late or early, with the harvest of the crop at the Veterans Hospital at Waco, Texas, completed last week.

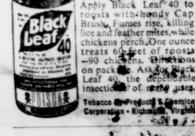

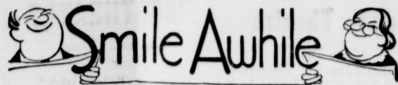

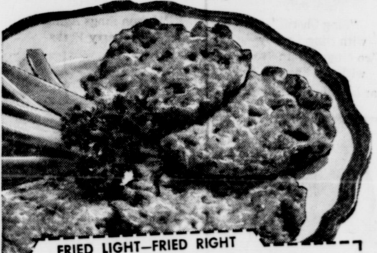
