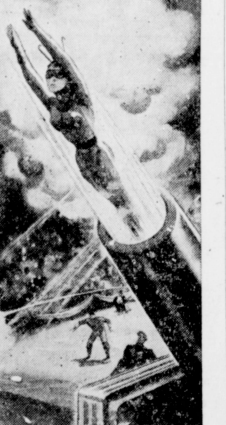

**How to Grow House Plants and Flowers**

**House Plants Ruined By Faulty Watering**

**POTTED chrysanthemums** are a fall favorite that bloom until near Christmas. They must be kept cool, and flourish best in a unheated room or sunporch.

Water only enough to keep them alive and in the spring start new plants by pinching off stems from tops of growing stems or using the new shoots around the base for slips.

Mums can be potted all year and planted outside in summer but during these winter months they need cool, moist air to survive.

You may want to know about preserving other indoor plants—cyclamen, primrose, cactus, geranium. Proper planting and watering for these and others are discussed in our booklet No. 28.
