You are aware that it will take 65 men and three officers to be mustered into the National Guard at this time. This will require something like 75 men as you are never able to get all the men on the floor at one and the same time and the law requires that you have the 65.

Would suggest that you go ahead and get all the signatures you can and if it looks sure that you can enlist the required men I will ask the Adjt. General to forward you the necessary papers.

You wil find this a very big job and one you will have to do considerable work and continuously, as you will not be able to get them all at one time but keep on at it, notifying me as you progress and I may be able to give you some advice as to how to proceed as I have had lots of experience along this line.
