The British view the battle in the most philosophical way, as the German ships in action on this oceasion outclassed the British cruisers, making their escape when the heavier English vessels appeared on the scene of action.

London, June 3.-Four thousand English were lost in the German British naval battle in the North Sea May 31. The dead include Admirals Hood and Arbuthnot. The men all lost their lives in defense of the Battleship Indefatigable and the Black Prince. It is feared the total dead will number five thousand when the smaller vessels are heard from,

The British Admiralty also admit that the torpedo destroyers Shark, Nomal and Nestor are also lost in the battle.

The German superdreadnought iHndenburg, the greatest of all fighting vessels, is reported to have gone down in the battle.
