WASHINGTON, June 28 .--- Carers by midnight or President Wilson will go after them. Those close to the president declare that there will be no delay because Carranza has demanded that Mexican prisoners held in this country be released and the embargo on foodstuffs into his country be lifted. The United States is holding no Mexican war prisoners and the Mexican prisoners in this country are charged with crime that must be settled in the conrts.

That's another question, according to administration officials, who declare that the president is now interested solely in getting twentyfour American prisoners out of the Chihuahua prison. Some believe that Carranza will yield and order the prisoners released. It is positively known that he at first intended releasing the prisers. The danger now lies in the possibility of Carranza asking that the United States "exchange prisoners." Should Carranza contend for this it would mean the immediate action for rescuing the Americans by force.
