LONDON, March 29.-It is expected that Chancellor von Bethmann-Hollweg will strive to stave off a rapidly growing sentiment for democratizing Germany by offering a new peace proffer today.

At the very least he is expected to anonunce sweeping reforms in Germany's governmental structure, and reforms that will give the people a more active participation, according to reliable reports received here.

Dispatches received indicate that the German populace is taking the most intense interest in a speech which the chancellor is scheduled to deliver before the Reichstag this afternoon. For the first time the German socialists have united in formidable demands which the government apparently realizes will have the backing of a large part of the German people.
