Geology Professor Traces Longhorn Cavern Formation BURNET - Texas Longhorn Cavern, a spectacular scenic mas-
terpiece of Nature, was at least a million years in the making geologists have estimated.
The huge cavern is awesome evidence of the changes wrought
through the ages by variation t through the ages by variations in
climate, earth movements, the climate, earth movements, the
rise and fall of the seas and the sow solution of limestone by
water. Today Longhorn Cavern, lo-
cated near Burnet in the Highcated near Burnet in the High
land Lakes region northwest of
Austin, is one of the state's fav Austin, is one of the state's fav-

sightsers. Guided tours are con-
