Eastland County Court Bill Is Approved In House; To Senate

Forfeited Land Sale Is Planned For Next April 3

Applications for land to be offered for sale in the fourth Veterans' Land Board forfeited land sale on April 3 are now available in Eastland, according to a report by County Veterans Service Officer James Wright. Applications may be secured from Wright.

The 52 tracts of land in 23 counties contains 3,932.7 acres, mostly in the northeast, central and southwest portions of the state. The largest tract to be offered is located five miles northwest of Rising Star in Eastland County. This tract contains 239 acres.

The previous similar sales were held in February of 1957 and in January and September, 1956.

Property to be offered by the land board in the April sale was originally bought by veterans through the Veterans' Land Program and was forfeited when the purchaser became delinquent in payments.

A U. S. Bureau of Labor was created in 1884.

Representative Paul Brashear's bill for the reorganization of area district courts passed the House of Representatives last Wednesday by a vote of 59 to 12 with 47 members registered as not voting. It was reported here. The bill would place Calahan County under the 91st District Court in Eastland and Shackelford County will be added to the 90th District in Breckenridge.

Both counties are now under the 42nd District Court in Abilene. The bill would make the 42nd District Court full-time for Abilene. It has been referred to the Senate for their approval or objection.

The bill was passed by the House despite open opposition by Representative Truett Latimer, of Abilene, who stated that a majority of Abilene lawyers opposed the reorganization measure.

Mr. Brashear, in an interview Saturday, stated, "The only objection that Abilene lawyers had was that the reorganization would enable them to try their cases too quickly. I do not feel a poll of the lawyers represents the view of 13,000 poll taxpayers in the county."

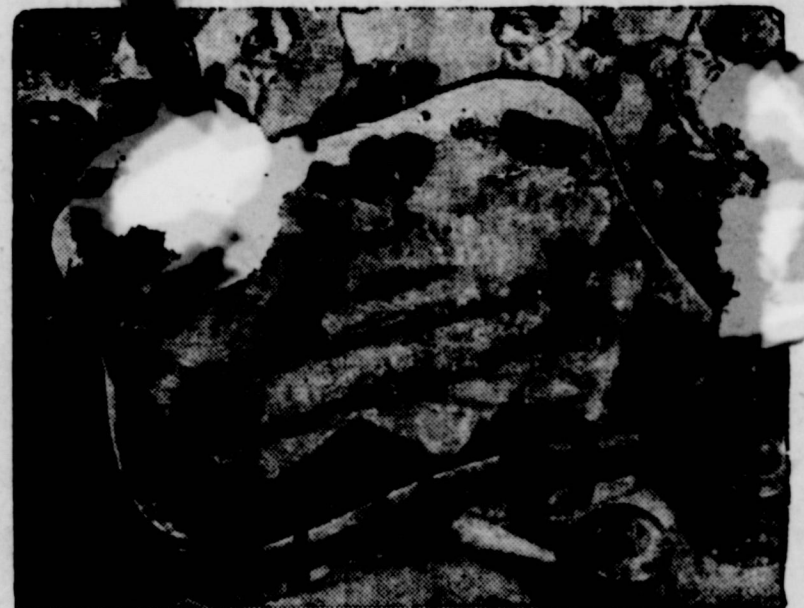

Sombbrero Tamales— Quick and Flavorful Oven Dish

Really fine eating, pardner, is this wonderfully delicious casserole of satisfying food which all the "cow punchers" in your family will praise and praise.

This quick oven dish is put together in a matter of minutes. It is almost an "out-of-the-can affair" because the rice cooks while you get out the cheese, the tamales and chili con carne and light the oven. This "savory favorite" from the southwest is different enough to make a big hit with company, too, and you'll find you won't need the "lasso" any compliments for it.

INGREDIENTS:

1 — 15 ounce can or jar of tamales and sauce
 3 cups cooked rice

1 — 15½ ounce can chili con carne with beans

¾ cup water

¼ lb. American cheese, sliced

PREPARING THE FLUFFY WHITE RICE: To make 3 heaping cups of white, fluffy, perfectly cooked rice:

1. Put 1 cup uncooked rice, 2 cups of cold water and 1 teaspoon of salt into a 2-quart saucepan and bring to a vigorous boil.

2. Turn the heat as low as possible. Cover the saucepan with a lid. Do not remove lid nor stir rice while it is cooking.

3. Leave saucepan over this low heat for 14 minutes. Remove from the heat. The rice is now ready to use.

For extra fluffy, tender, separate grains allow the rice to steam for an additional 10 minutes — with heat off, but without removing lid.

For extra convenience and economy of time and effort, cook 2 cups of rice, 4 cups of water and 2 teaspoons of salt — keeping the extra cups of unused ready-cooked rice in the refrigerator in a covered container.

Use this rice as needed in quick, delicious and inexpensive soups, salads, casserole dishes, hot breads and desserts.

METHOD: Place the tamales and sauce in the bottom of a greased 2-quart baking dish. Top with the cooked rice. Pour the chili con carne over the rice.

Add the water. Place the cheese slices over the top of the chili con carne. Place in a 350°F. oven for 30 minutes or until the cheese has melted and the tamales, rice and chili con carne mixture is heated through.

If desired, save out three of the tamales and arrange them on the top of the cheese in the shape of a sombrero. Do this about 10 minutes before the cooking time is over in order that these tamales may become hot.

This recipe makes 8 servings.

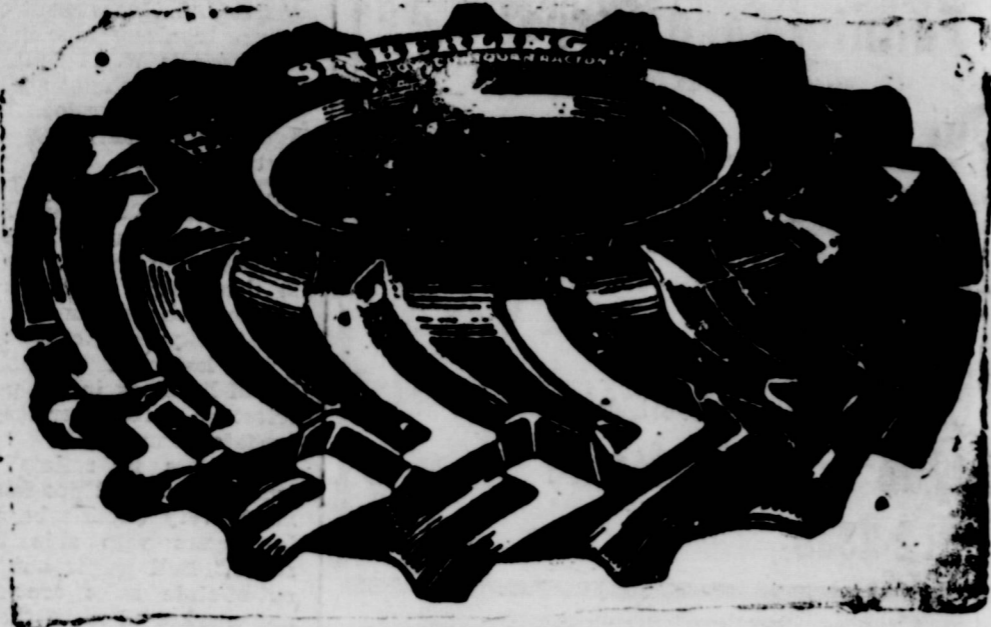

Increase Reported For E Bond Sales

E Bond sales in Texas during January increased 5.4% over the same month in 1956.

This announcement was made today by Nathan Adams, chairman, and Ed Gossett, state co-chairman of the Savings Bonds Committee for Texas. Total sales for the month were \$17,607,189 which is 9.1% of the state 1957 goal of \$193,100,000.

Guy P. Parker, Eastland County Chairman, reported that sales in this county amounted to \$32,836 during January.

"By purchasing U. S. Savings Bonds the people of Eastland County not only help themselves but also help in the Nation's battle against inflation," Chairman Parker stated.

Late Friday afternoon the Wrangler squad had qualified in all but two events for Saturday's final runnings. The Wranglers didn't qualify in the 120-yard high hurdles or the high jump.

Bruce Land and Roger Wagner qualified for the 100 yard dash. Land had the best time of the heats with a 10.3. James Morris and Gus Umphress qualified for the 440 yard dash. Land and Robert Reagan qualified for the 220 yard dash.

Tracey Byrd qualified for the shot putt finals by tossing the best distance of 45 ft. and 6 inches. Glenn Welling qualified in the discus throw with a 112 ft. 6 in. Land jumped a distance of 17 ft. 1 1/2 inches to qualify in the broad jump finals.

Lesley Fisher and Marshall Lawrence qualified in the pole vault event. Fisher was in a two-way tie, with the best height of 12 ft. and 2 1/2 inches.

The finals were to be held Saturday, and Coaches Arnett Weeks and Houston Kelley will return home with the wrangler squad sometime Sunday night or early Sunday morning.

USDA Approves 50 Livestock Auction Barns For Sales

Texas farmers and ranchers can now sell their livestock at more markets and auction barns subject to the high standards set by the U. S. Department of Agriculture than any time in history. So reports W. C. Ball, district supervisor, Packers and Stockyard Branch, Livestock Division, Agricultural Marketing Service, Fort Worth.

The Sig Faircloth Livestock Commission Company, Eastland, along with about 50 other Texas livestock yards are now subject to these high standards spelled out by Congress in the Packers and Stockyards Act.

This law regulates the marketing of livestock in the public interest at yards operating in interstate commerce.

"Changes in railroading and trucking make it possible for almost every auction barn to sell to buyers who ship to other states," Ball points out. "When out-of-state sales are made at any market of more than 20,000 square feet, its operations are subject to the Act."

This means that the services and facilities must be adequate, that the yardage, commission, feed and other charges must be reasonable, that all livestock be offered on the open market and sold under competitive bidding, that the weighing of livestock must be accurate and that correct accountings be rendered to sellers and buyers.

Primary purpose of the regulations is to assure farmers and ranchers of fair treatment in the market place.
