

It is assured that neither Smithkins nor Goldbonds have dependents, other than a wife. The new revenue bill allows on additional exemption of \$200 for each person dependent upon the taxpayer for chief support, if such person incapable of self support.

At their option Goldbonds may pay their tax in full at the time of filing their returns, on or be fore March 15, or in four installfore December 15. The penalty for failure to make a return on time is a fine of not more than \$1,000 and an additional assessment of 25 per cent of the amount due. For "willfully refusing," to make a return the penalty is a fine of not more than \$10,000 or imprisonment for not more than one year, or both. A similar penalty is profided for making a false or fraudlent return, together with an added assessment of 50 per cent of the amount due.
