### FINISHING TOUCH IN DRILLING CONTRACT

The five thousand dollar deosit was made today by the Safety First Oil & Gas Co., and the 'finishing touch'' put to the drilling contract in which the above oil company contracts to begin drilling an oil well on Los Arroyo, or in that territory just west of the city within ninety days, or by July the first.

F. W. Hunter, president of the company who is here, received a telegram from the directors of his company Thursday, directing him to have geological survey made at once, drilling site selected and to proceed with the work just as fast as it could be done.

Mr. Hunter stated Thursday morning that he would leave for Fort Worth in a day or two where he goes to make a contract with driller and arrange for a speedy operation.




