# Twelve Die As Balloon Goes Down

Chicago, July 22.-The death list in the balloon disaster reached twelve today when Milton Norton, Newspaper photographer, died from injuries sustained when he dropped from the burning dirigible while flying over Chicago yesterday.

None of the bank employees were killed when the machine fell through the skylight of a bank, crashing to the floor. Two of the pilots of the machine are included in the death list. A corners investigation is underway to-
