CONCHO COUNTY OIL OPERATIONS

The following clipping from The Stan Angelo Standard terday. the standing of the Leonard well on the Waring Ranch in Concho county, and also tells of the operations on the Schultz well near JEANES PRODUCE CO. Paint Rock.

In Concho county the Schultz Oil Company on the W. O. Schultz Ranch near Paint Rock is engaged in underreaming 5 3-16 inch easing to over 3,100 feet. The depth is supposed to be nearer 3.200 feet.

Oil struck three or four weeks ago in the Waring well of the Leonard Petroleum Company near Eden, Concho county, tested out thirty-two gravity, so that it is of a low grade containing little gasoline. The petroleum was dark in color and very thick. The underreaming of 6 5-8 inch casing for a distance of 120 feet down to the 2.910 foot level is now in progress, the work having been started Monday, according to a report reaching this city.






FOOTBALL TEAM AT SANTA ANNA TODAY


