# TO SPEND MORE?

AUSTIN, May 28 .- An amend ment to the fire insurance commission law was submitted to the legislature today by Governor Hobby. The amendment proposed seeks to remove the limitation restricting the expenditures of commission to \$130,000 per year. Under the present law the tax of one and one-fourth percent of the gross business of the insurance only \$130,000 can be spent.


