Germany Yields to Allied **Demands With Changes**

SPA, Belgium, July 15 .- The Germans have agreed to the allied demands for the delivery, of two million tons of coal monthly, with three new conditions added to the demands, it is announced this afternoon.

The conditions are that the German government is to have the distribution of Silesian coal or be allotted one million five hundred thousand tons monthly for Northern Germany, instead of the present allotment of one million three hundred thousand tons.

The second added condition is that a mixed commission will be sent to Essen to examine the food and housing conditions.

The third is the allies are asked by Germany to advance money or provide credit for importing additional food for the entire German population.

Foreign Minister Simmons, of the German delegation, said that he acceded to the demands of the allies to prevent the sending of an ultimatum to Germany.






