STATE ENGINEERS ARE AT WORK ON SURVEY

C. S. Guin, president of the Colorado Valley Irrigation Association, received a phone message from Bronte early Saturday morning stating that the first preliminary work in making a survey of the Colorado irrigation project was started Friday.

According to the message Engineers Prichett and Norris of the State Board of Water Engineers, and Engineers Dudley and Fellows of the federal government, spent several days looking over the site of the proposed dam and getting the lay of the land, and Mr. Prichett had been left to carry on the preliminary work, while the other three Engineers had gone to the Pacos for a few days, but would return shortly to assist Mr. Prichett in his work.

THREE CASES OF SLEEPING SICKNESS

AUSTIN, Feb. 12.-Three case during January, according to a report made by Dr. H. M. Carrick state health officer. The health officer insisted that there is no cause for alarm.

There is no connection between the disease in Texas and the African sleeping sickness, which results from infection by the tsetse fly, Dr. Carrick said.

"There must be a sharp line drawn between the African sleep ing sickness and this, the cause of which is a mystery," the health officer said. "There is a feeling on the part of the medical profes sion that the disease here is related in some way to influneza, but this is pure theory.'



It is rather for us to be here dedicate ed to the great task remaining be fore us-that from these honored dead we take increased devotion to that cause for which they gay the last full measure of deve ion-that we here highly resolv that these dead shall not have died in vain-that this nation, under God, shall have a new birth of freedom and that government of the people, by the people, and for the people shall not perish from the earth.

That speech made fifty sever years ago, is appropriate for today. From time to time, as we pause to observe Armistic Day, or pay tribute to those who died in the World War, we should not for get that if we fail in carrying or the fight for which our heroes died, their dying will have been

most critical period in its history. That freedom and patriot ism planted in America by our forefathers more than fourscore and sixty years ago is the guid ing spirit for the reconstruction period. The world is looking to America as the leader of nation and vengence should be meeted out to the politician who sacrifice the principles of true Americanism to foster his selfish end.
