# THE COMMERCIAL USE OF TEXAS HIGHWAYS IS A PRIVILEGE, NOT A RIGHT

• The highways of Texas are the property of its citizens. They constitute a system of nearly 200,000 miles of road of which 20,000 miles are desig-nated as State highways and the remainder are county roads. All types of road are represented in this system, bess than 5% have so-called "yermasent" surface.

The total cost of these highways is unknown but it amounts to many hundred million dollars. From 1917 to 1980, inclusive, counties and road districts of the State issued \$243,592,834 in bonds for the construction and improvement of roads and bridges. In the two-year period ending August 81, 1980, the State Highway Commission expended \$89,032,825, of which \$2,488,426 was for maintenance of the State highways.

In view of these tremendous costs the preservation of our highways from rapid wear and destruction is a matter of very vital interest to their own-ers, viz., the public. It is especially important that they be made to outlast the life of the bonds, which run from 20 to 80 years.

The use of the public highways for commercial purposes is not a right and safeguard the interests of the public.

Texas Reilroads, which pay the entire cost of construction and mainte-pance of their own roadbeds and, in addition, make substantial contribu-tions to the cost of Texas highways, are thoroughly regulated with respect to their services, rates, methods and practices. There is no good reason why commercial users of the highways, built and maintained at the expense of the public, should not likewise be regulated to such extent as the public instructions and pay such charges as will represent proper compensa-tion for the frivileges granted them.

• The statutes governing highway transportation as enacted by the Forty-second Legislature represent the wishes of the citizens of this State and supress their design to give equal rights to all and special privileges to none. These statutes should be given a fair (rial and their value accertained, unless the is done, a chaotic condition in transportation as a whole will diright same.
