



MOTOR TRIPS ABROAD SERIES THE EIFFEL TOWER




Photo Couriery Chrysler Maxwell Motor Corps VERY visitor to Paris sees Eiffel Tower near the Seine and opposite the Trocadero, built by Gustave Eiffel, the engincer, for the Universal Exhibition of 1889. This tower has acquired Importance of recent years as a physical observatory, a meteorlogical station and especially as one of the most powerful wireless stations in the world with a range of 4,500 miles.

The base of the tower rests on to a depth of 46 feet on the side of the Seine and 29 feet on the other side, and forms a square of 142 yards each way. The first platform, 190 feet above the ground, is over 71 yards square. The second platform is 380 feet high. The third platform 905 feet high, has a glass pavilion of 54 square feet capable of holding 800 people.




