

DALLAS, May 21.—Broken windows, a few bullet marks in the walls of structures near the Dallas county jail, streets littered with broken bottles, bricks, railroad spikes, and other missles, marked the scene at daybreak today of attempts of a mob to storm the county prison to get two negroes held in jail charged with murder and criminal assault.

Five members of the crowd were wounded when the officers shot into the mob to stop the rush being made on the jail. Dwight Stewart, age 18, was shot in the abdomen and is reported to be in a serious condition, and others are less seriously hurt.

(By Associated Press) CHICAGO, May 21.—Sales of evaporated milk in the United States reached a total value of \$117,272,585 in 1924, according to the annual report of the industry issued here by Herbert C. Hooks, secretary of the Evaporated Milk Association.

Export sales last year totaled 2,959,236 cases, a gain of 107,437





'CAPTAIN BLOOD'

A genuine old relic of the sailing days of 1827 is used as a chart in the sequences of the picturization of Rafael Sabatini's famous novel. Captain Blood, which will be shown at the Queen Theatre on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday of next week. It is a globe which J. Warren Kerrigan as Captain Blood uses to chart the courses of his pirate ship, "Arabella."

Aside from being authentic as the instrument used by the ancient navigators it holds interest in that the last corrections as to explorations and territorial lines were made in the year 1827. 


