





#### APPEALS COURT AFFIRMS COLLIER MURDER CASE

A decision handded down -by the Court of Criminal Appeals Wednesday affirms the threeyear sentence of Frank Collier, former mayor of Wiehita Falls, for killing his son-in-law, Buster Robertson, at Wichita Falls about a year ago. Collier must serve a three-year sentence. Collier's counsel appeared before the appeals court a short time ago and stated that there were no grounds for a reversal of the ease, the substance of which meant that Collier was ready to accept the verdict.

The appeals court Wednesday also affirmed the case of Alvin Townsley, convicted and given a life sentence for the murder of at Georgetown in October, 1924. These two cases had been abiding citizens of Texas.
