College, county home demonstration agent in 170 Texas counties held, last year, almost 2,000 leadership training meetings, total attendance exceed- ing 25,000 . ing 25,000 . <br> Training was recelved in extension organization and planning, home marketing, home management, landscaping, home food supply, clothing, family life, and recreation. The trained leaders in turn held 9,401 meetings that were attended by more than 137,000 women. In addition to the meetings, these trained leaders gave <br> Individual help to more than 73,- 000 women. Girls' 4-H club work also received a lot of help from trained leaders. The leaders conducted almost 3,000 training meetings that were attended by $72,000 \quad 4-\mathrm{H}$ members and they helped another 29,000 Miss Midual members. It all adds up. contribution to family and community improvement in the state. This leader training program, she points out, has resulted in more self-confidence on the part of the leaders; leaders now have a better understanding of the problems; better meetings are being conducted in the local clubs: 4-H leadership from the standpoint of adults has improved and because of the assistance they have received from the leaders, visits.
