No Longer Number One ... 90 to 100 Gins To "Lay Up and Down. Calt Sales Decline ... Broiler Production Texas is no longer the number one cattle feeding state in the nation. The state lost that long held honor to lowa as of
Feb. 1. Cattle and calves on feed in Texas number 1,237,000. Iowa's total is $1,250,000$ head.
Cattle on feed in Texas have been cut virtually in half in a year's time. The number of cattle on feed a year ago in
the state totaled $2,340,000$ head. Compare that with the the state totaled $2,340,000$ head. Compare that with the
latest figures and you have a 47 per cent decline. latest figures and you have a 47 per cent decline.
Nationwide, cattle on feed in the seven major
states.-Texas, lowa, Nebraska, Colorado, Arizona, California, and Kansas-are down 37 per cent from a year ago. As of Feb. 1, cattle numbers in these states totaled
$6,050,000$ head compared to $9,632,000$ a year ago 6,050,000 head compared to $9,632,000$ a year ago.

OF THE state's 900 cotton gins, about 90 to 100 are not expected to be operating this season due to projected cuts
in cotton acres. This does not mean those gins which do not open this year are going out of business permanently, however.
Not as many gins are expected to be idle on the High Plains this year since cotton acres probably won't be cut as
much in that area as other sections of the much in that area as other sections of the state.
A reduction of 23 per cent in cotton acres is forecast for Texas this season. This figure is based on Jan. 1 intentions. Weather and improvements in the cotton price picture can
yet change the final figure, even though cotton planting is now underway in the southern parts of the state. Planting
there is off to a slow start because of the weather Hower projections now are that perhaps less than 50 per cent of, the acreage to cotton in the Valley last year will be planted

SALES of cattle, calves, sheep and goats in Texas during January were 28 per cent below a yeear ago, the Texas Crop
and Livestock Reporting Service notes. and Livestock Reporting Service notes.
However, sales for hogs continued year ago. There were 482,000 cattle and calves marketed through
auctions during January, a decline of 28 per auctions during January, a decline of 28 per cent from a

a year ago. Goat sales were 27 per cent below a year ago. The Texas Animal Health Commission reports only a
third as many cattle and calves were shipped out of Texas during January of this year as there were a year ago.
BROILER production in Texas as of the middle of February was down seven per cent from a year ago, bu
shows an increase of 12 per cent from the previous week.
