In Russia demands are uttered for revolution, but the leader is obscured. Does he exist? At any rate, some dominant force must be at work. Here is a subject concerning which the cables are silent. A possible commanding figure is being cheated of fame. A maker of history—whether he be an anarchist, monster or hero—is being ignored.
