## NEW ROAD LAW,

The law oresting a more effioient road eystem in Milla eounty has been signed by the governor and as it carries the ewergency clause it is now in full force in this county.
This law makes each commisaioner ex-officio road commiasioser and allows him $\$ 2.50$ per day for his services, provided ke doee not receive more than $\$ 240$ for such service io any one year. He is allowed to have a deputy to do the work if he so desires, out in that case the deputy gete the pay. The commissioners oourt is to continue to exercise general aupervision over tue road work in the evunty and can open and close rjada at will and may work roads and build bridger by eontract.
Each commisaioner bas aupervieion over the roal overseers in his precinct. Any person appointed road overseer who faile to perform the duties is liable to a fiue of \$25, unters he has a valid excuse. Esch overseer shali be allowed $\$ 150$ per day for all work on the road except for the five daye required by law, provided he does the extra work by instruation of the commianioner All tools, machinery, eto., neoeasary for the work that may be owned by the county shall be delivered to the road overseer, who shall give a receipt for it and ahall not allow ite uee for private purposea.
A man liable for road duty has the privilegs of paying $\$ 3$ on or before February 1st to the commisaioner of hie precinct or to the county treasurer and receiving therefor a receipt which will exemp: him from road duty for the ourrent year and persons who fail to pas poll tax shall be liable for three daye extra road duty.
All money collected from those liable for road duty shall be placed to the oredit of the preoivet in which they reaide and all changes and new roads shall be paid for out of funde belonging to the precinct where the roada are located.
The commissioners sourt has power to order an election to determine whether or not a tax of 15 cente of the $\$ 100$ valuation
of property shall be levied in the county and this apecial tax does not exempt from road duty those who pay it. In this connection it is underatood that the court now hse in contemplation the ordering of such election and the proclamation will probably be issutd next week.
