



Senate Joint Resolution No. 3

proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of Texas, amending Article 5, Section 2 of the Constitution of said State, so as to provide that the Supreme Court of this State shall consist of a Chief Justice and four Associate Justices, describe their qualifications, tenure of office and com-

Be it resolved by the Legislature of the State of Texas:

Section 1. That Section 2, of Article 5, of the Constitution of the State of Texas be amended so as to tereafter read as follows: .

Section 3. The Supreme Court shall consist of Chief Justice and four Associate Justices, any three of whom shall constitute a quorum, and Mrs. C. F, Jones and little son and the concurrence of three judges shall to the office of Chief Justice or Associate Justice of the Supreme Court unless he be at the time of his election a citizen of the United States, and of this State, and unless he shall Will sell all together or separately. have attained the age of thirty years and shall have been a practicing lawyer or a Judge of a Court, or such lawver and judge together, at least seven years. Said Chief Justice and Associate Justices shall be elected by the qualified voters of the State at a general election, shall hold their offices six years, or until their successors are elected and qualified and shall each receive an annual salary of five thousand dollars until otherwise provided by law. In case of a vacancy in the office of Chief Justice of the Supreme Court, the Governor shall fill the vacancy until the next general election for said officers; and at such general election the vacancy for the unexpired term shall be filled by election by the qualified voters of the State. 

Be it resolved by the Legislature of the State of Texas:

Section 1. That Section 9. Article 8, of the Constitution of the State of Texas be amended so as to hereafter read as follows, to-wit:

Section 9. A Joint Resolution proposing and submitting to a vote of the people of Texas an amendment to Section 52 of Article 3 of the Constitution, authorizing the issuance of bonds for public improvements, and levying of a tax to pay the interest and sinking fund on same, and for maintenance.

Pe it resolved by the Legislature of the State of Texas:

Section 1. That Section 52, of Article 3, of the Constitution of the State of Texas be amended so as hereafter to read as follows, to-wit:

Section 52. 
