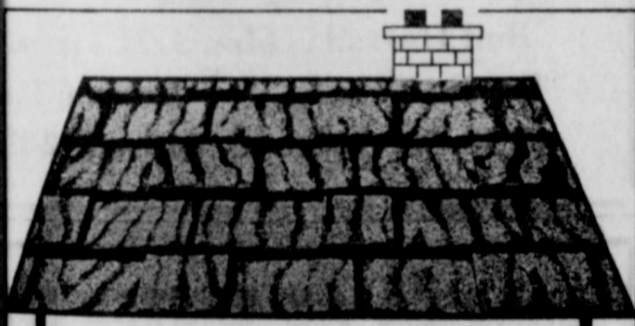

Four Leaders Of Mills Farm Bureau Participate In Statewide Activity

Four leaders of the Mills County Farm Bureau participated in a special statewide Farm Bureau membership report activity October 26. They were Mr. and Mrs. Homer McCasland and Mr. and Mrs. W. G. Bishop. The District 7 meeting they attended in Brownwood was one of 13 such meetings held that evening across the state. Mills County turned in a report showing 303 member families signed up as of that date. The end of the Farm Bureau fiscal year is October 31. Mills County has a goal of 316 members for this year. Last year's membership was 306. A telephoned report of membership results in the district was made that evening to Texas Farm Bureau President Sidney Dean in Waco. When reports from all districts had been compiled, the TFB leader called each district meeting with statewide results. As of October 26, the Texas Farm Bureau membership stood at 119,656. The state's largest farm organization ended its fiscal year last October 31st with a total membership of 116,622 families, making it the third largest state Farm Bureau in the nation. B. G. Gist of Abilene, District 7 Director, urged all counties in this district to make a special effort to help bring the TFB membership to 125,000 for the year. The national Farm Bureau meeting will be in Houston in December, and the Texas Farm Bureau hopes to be recognized there for having a gain in every one of its 203 organized county Farm Bureaus. In a special message read to the assembled leaders, Dean reminded them that the strength of Farm Bureau is within its membership. "Front burner" issues in which Farm Bureau is active presently were discussed by the TFB field representative, J. D. Jordan of Mason, and the District director. These included a discussion of Amendment No. 3 which will be voted on in the November 3 general election, policy development activities, and progress in involving both Farm Bureau women and young adults in the organization's program of work.

In response to numerous requests from families and individuals, the American Heart Association has begun a memorial fund to which families and friends of victims of cardiovascular diseases may contribute, according to Lee Puckett, director of Region VIII, of which Mills County is a part. 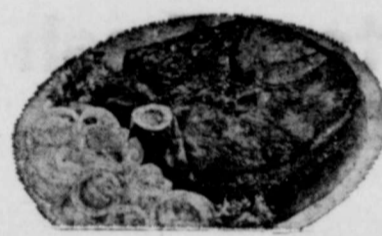
