Mills County Receives \$20,005 In Revenue Sharing

And The Mullin Enterprise

Mills County was richer by \$20,005 this week as a result of the recently passed Revenue Sharing bill by the Congress of the United States.

The \$20,005 amount represents the County's portion of a fiveyear program which was signed into law by President Nixon on October 20.

A few "strings" are attached to the expenditure of revenue sharing funds. State governments may expend their revenue sharing payments for any lawful purpose. Units of local governments have discretion to expend their payments on broad categories of priority expenditures described in the Act and on any lawful ordinary and necessary capital expenditure.

The Comptroller will return the 1 per cent City Sales Tax money to

the City.
