



Ranchers Receive Nearly \$1 Million In Emergency Funding

Livestock producers in Mills County received County. \$985,367.92 in emergency feed aid between November 14, 1977 and April 14, 1979 to help them purchase 58,977,976 pounds of feed. it was reported by Lee Roy Schwartz, Chairperson of the Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation (ASC) committee.

"This assistance was provided under our emergency feed program to help livestock producers preserve foundation herds and prevent wide-spread selling or destroying of herds due to natural disaster", Schwartz said. Of the 1017 applications received during the period, 950 were approved.

To have been eligible for the emergency feed funds, farmers must have suffered a substantial loss in the amount of feed normally produced, have had insufficient feed for the period of the disaster, and must have purchased larger - than normal quantities of feed.

According to Schwartz, participants were reimbursed up to 50% of the cost for emergency period. This,







According to charter member Steen, the local Lions Club was organized to promote the paving of roads in Mills County. At the time of its inception, roads hereabouts were at times impassable, and always irritating to travel. The club was very instrumental in achieving this initial goal.

· Invited the women's basketball team, the Red Heads to play here, including Goldthwaite's own Marie Reynolds.

· Helped move the grandstands from Fair Park to the baseball field.

· Provided fund raising for the Mills County Park and Pool proposals.

· Sponsored a lighted community notice sign.

· Was instrumental in the procurement of the REA electricity idea for this rural area, and also the telephone system for the rural user.

· Bought inumerable pairs of eyeglasses for needy persons.

· Led in the Christmas shopping promotion, by providing Santa Claus for the youngsters and a nice parade each year.

· Sponsored the purchase of the Christmas lights for Goldthwaite.

· Sent children to the Crippled Children's Camp, and also provided counselors for the camp.

Sponsored a Boy Scout troop.

· Sponsored "Trades Day" merchant promotions. Held several RCA approved rodeos.

· Constructed a portable concession stand for community use.

· Participated in the financing and construction of the American Legion Hall in Goldthwaite.

· Sponsors the annual Fiddlet's Festival for Mills County.

· Provides workers and sponsors the annual Eagle Relays track meet each spring.
