Texas 4-H Summer Camp Will host about 1,000 youth this July for five 3-day sessions, in which they will learn canoeing, archery and outdoor cookery, among other activities, points out Judy C. Beavers, County

Held at the Texas 4-H Center, overlooking Lake Brownwood in Central Texas, the summer camp will include sessions for three age groups and provide food and lodging. Age groups are senior youth (ages 15 & up), youth ages (10-11), and youth ages (12-14).

The Texas 4-H Center features 78 acres of wooded land for outdoor activities: 10 housing units, swimming pool, baseball field, Tennis and Volleyball courts, and facilities for basketball and shuffleboard.

A Little Below Area Average

Goldthwaite Shows Gain In City Sales Tax Allocations

Texas cities shared \$218 million in rebates from the one percent optional city sales tax during the first six months of this year. State Comptroller Bob Bullock said last week in announc-

ing June's tax allocations. This figure compares to \$196.4 million that cities received during the same six months during 1978.

just about a ten percent overall increase in the state's taxable sales. In Goldthwaite, the sales

The payment for the month of June was over 20 percent higher than the one registered in 1978. The total payments for the year, however, reflect a smaller increase. The city received \$6,920.51 for its June

allocation of sales tax. So far this year, Goldthwaite has collected

\$18,829.74 in sales taxes. Other Central Texas communities reflect the same modest growth as Goldthwaite, some a little higher and some a little lower.

· Brownwood's sales tax collection for June was \$117,479.46, an increase of six percent. Over \$360,000 in sales taxes have been collected by the City of Brownwood thus far in



The tax relief legislation recently signed by the Governor is what the agricultural landowner has been looking forward to for some local taxes. time. In 1980, all taxing authorities must offer these landowners an opportunity to render their taxes based

This week we will answer four more questions on tax relief as follows: 1. Can this method raise

my taxes? The law provides that the tax assessor make available to any applicant the value under this method to compare with the value under the fair market value of the previous year (and also the Article 8, Sec. 1-d value if it is different). Then the landowner would simply not apply if the agricultural use evaluation were higher than another method, so that no taxpayer would receive a higher evaluation on this land because of this
