## Plan Temporary Quarters Opening

Preliminary approval to organize a na tional bank in Bovina has been granted by national officials.

Plans are now being made to open temporary headquarters for the bank in 15 to 30 days, says C. R. Elliott, one of the directors of the bank.

The bank, to be titled "First National Bank of Bovina" will have a capital of $\$ 50,000$., surplus $\$ 50,000$., and undivided profits of $\$ 25,000$.

A directors meeting will be called sometime within the next week to fill out and sign the necessary papers and return them to Washington. Stockholders in the bank will be notified by personal mail that the application of charter has been approved and it is neof charter has been approved and it is ne-
