The farmers and ranchers in the trade territory north of Merkel are faced with the possibility of a disaster, the loss of the services of a valuable Agricultural helper, the predatory animal trapper. Jones County has employed a trapper for many years, paid for jointly by the County and other Governmental agencies. At the election next Tuesday you will be asked to vote on whether or not to continue this important service for the farmers and ranchers of this county

During recent years many of the people have moved from the country to the cities and towns, and the wild animals, especially the coyotes and wildcats, have increased in numbers.

Unless the predatory animals are kept under control, it is impossible to raise sheep, goats, turkeys and chickens, and the coyotes sometimes even attack young calves. Coyotes and foxes also carry rabies, and are a menace to young humans, especially young children, as well as to livestock.

Our Jones County trapper has kept these animals under control for the past few years, and it would be a disaster to the farmers and ranchers of Jones County to discontinue his services.
