## Long Life For Cut Flowers Challenge

Making cut flowers
look good for the longest
possible time is a chal-
lenge faced by many
home gardeners.
Dr. William C. Welch,
landscape horticulturist
with the Texas Agri-
cultural Extension Ser-
vice, offers the following
tips to help give longer
life to cut flowers, whe-
ther homegrown or from
your local florist:

1. Make Certain the
container is wa s h ed
clean with soap and
water before using.
2. Cut stems at a
slant, using a sharp
knife or shears.
3. Before cutting, se-
lect flowers that are not
fully open; avoid cutting old flowers.
4. Rem from the lower third of the stem; also remove all broken and bruised parts of the stem.
5. Cut flowers in eari morning or late after noon. Wash flowers and sprays or dusts if poss spray
ble.
6. 
7. Store cut flowers a cool area or refrige 8. On receiving bulk flowers from the florist, cut about one inch off
the stem ends
8. Do not place the arrangement in direct sun, near gas fires or oil
