Pets need dented care by Kathryn Banner DVM Merkel Votinarian Clinic

Teeth are important to our pets
and livestock and dental care is and livestock and dental care is important to those teeth. The type
of dental problems will vary from species to species, but all need to be cared for.
Dogs and cats rarely have dental caries (cavities) but they
do occur. A more common blem is tartar. The accumulation of tartar on the teeth can lead to bad breath, gum disease, and loss of teeth. Several things can be
done to help prevent tartar build-up and gum disease. A good balanced diet of hard food is important. (Dog food for dogs and "human" food, especially sweets. "Chew" toys and large, raw soup bones are helptul. Rubbing the teeth and gums with a soft cloth and baking soda is good. Frequent
check-ups and teeth cleans when needed can help prevent loss of teeth.
Horse
Horses have some special dental molars can develop sharp, uneven points. These points can injure the tongue and the inside of the filed down or "floated". Horses also have teeth called "wolf teeth". They are in the area that the bridle bit lies and sometimes
need to be removed to prevent need to be removed to
interference with the bit.
Cows seem to have less problem with their teeth than other animals. Their teeth can become
worn down as the cow ages and eating may become difficult These cows are usually culled. One interesting fact about cows and their teeth is that cows do no
have upper incisors (front teeth) Rodent pets and rabbits should be checked frequently for teeth problems. Their incisors can become overgrown (too long) for the animal to eat
For all animal species the
inability to eat or drink dribbling food out of the mouth while eating and weight loss can be signs of teeth problems. Other signs can be drooling and bad breath. If any of these signs are noticed, a thor ougn and treatment under taken as needed to correct the problem. Teeth are important for facial appearance, or processing and sometimes for protection. of the body.
