### CITATION BY PUBLICATION

The State of Texas.  
To the Sheriff or Any Constable of Donley County—Greeting:

You are hereby commanded to summon Della McCall by making publication of this citation once in each week for four consecutive weeks previous to the return day hereof, in some newspaper published in your county, if there be a newspaper published therein, but if not, then in the nearest county where a newspaper is published, to appear at the next regular term of the District Court of Donley County to be holden at the court house thereof in Clarendon, on the 2nd Monday in January, 1923, the same being the 8th day of January, 1923, then and there to answer a petition filed in said court on the 15th day of November, A. D. 1922, in a suit numbered on the docket of said court No. 1248, wherein Z. R. McCall is plaintiff and Della McCall is defendant, said petition alleging: That the plaintiff and defendant are husband and wife, they having been lawfully married, and such marriage never having been dissolved; that the defendant is now away from the plaintiff, and her residence is unknown to the plaintiff; that the defendant's excessive and cruel treatment renders their further living together as husband and wife insupportable; wherefore plaintiff prays the court that plaintiff be cited to appear and answer herein and for judgment dissolving said marriage relations, for costs of suit, and for such other and further relief special and general, in law and in equity, that he may be justly entitled to, etc.
