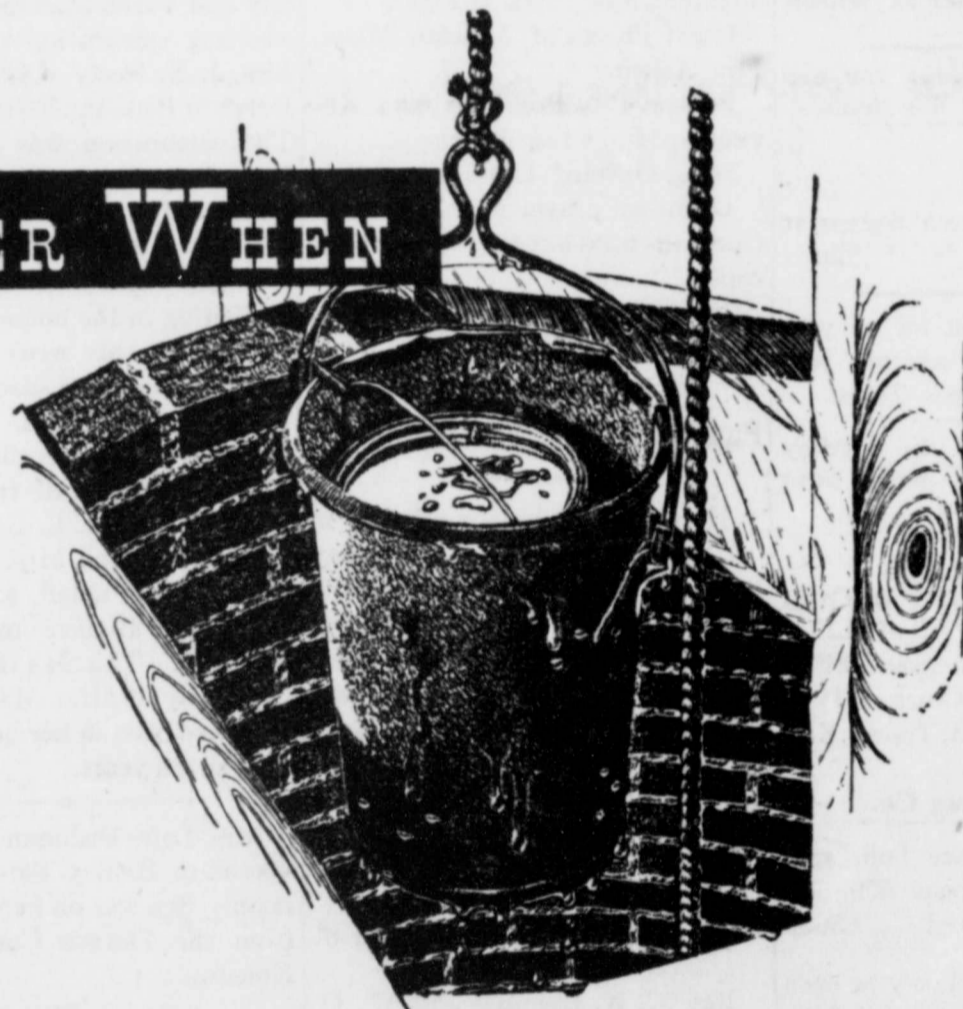

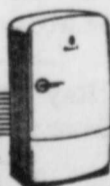

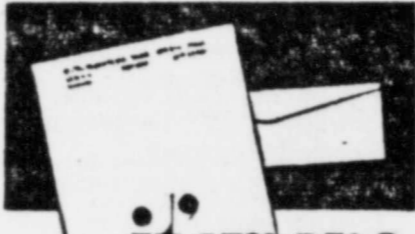

Robert S. Calvert, a native Texan, was born in McLennan County near McGregor, Texas and at an early age moved with his family to Brownwood, where he attended public schools and Howard Payne College.

At the age of 20 Bob moved to Sweetwater, where he was employed by the Santa Fe Railroad as clerk warehouse foreman and cashier; then by West Texas Electric Co. as chief clerk; and was assistant cashier of the First National Bank.

In 1917 he enlisted in the U. S. Army. Following basic training at San Antonio and technical training at Cornell University, he served with the Air Forces in France and Germany.

Among Bob Calvert's many friends in Sweetwater was George H. Sheppard, who became State Comptroller in 1930. Mr. Sheppard appointed Calvert to the position of financial statistician the same year. As head of the central accounting division for 14 years, Calvert gained first-hand knowledge of the state financing. In 1944 he was made chief clerk, the position next in line and authority to the Comptroller's.

Following the death of Mr. Sheppard on January 18, 1949, Governor Beauford H. Jester gave recognition to a career worker who had advanced through the ranks by appointing Calvert State Comptroller.

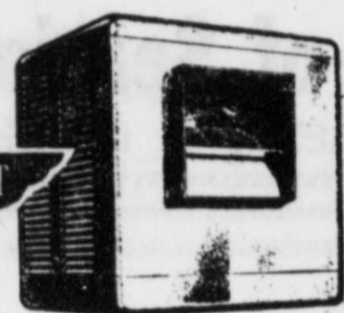


