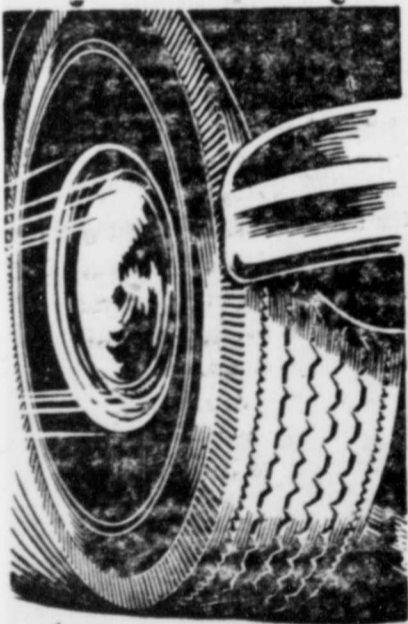
Sixth Grade Picnic
