The Kilgores have two children, Paula 4½ years old and Bob, 11 months old.

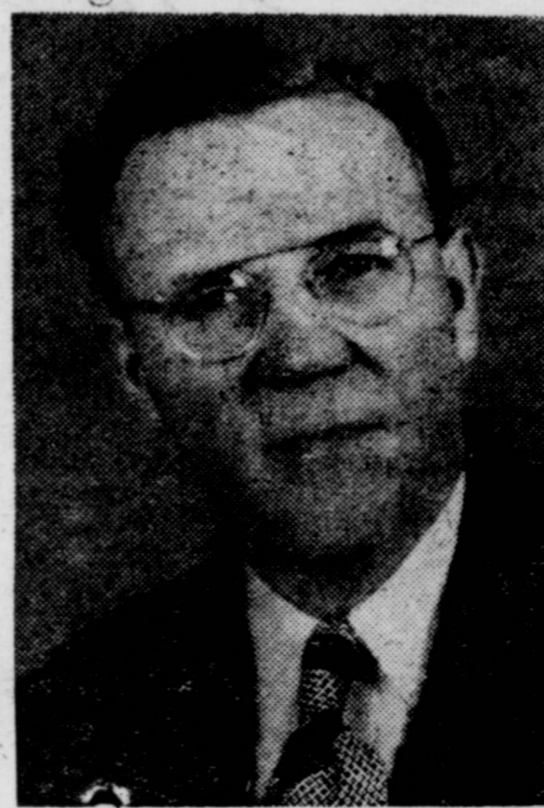
## Legion Auxiliary

## Longhorn Cavern Is Worth Visit

Texas has been famous for many things, but we learned a new one recently when we visited Longhorn Cavern south of Burnet. This cavern is the third largest in the world, and has been visited by around 250,000 persons since it was opened in 1932.

The entrance to Longhorn Cavern State Park is four miles south of Burnet on highway 281, and the cave entrance is about six miles west of the park gateway.

Some eight miles of the cave have been explored, two miles of which are brightly lighted and open to the public, the trip requiring about two hours.

The cave contains many interesting formations and we especially enjoyed guide Oscar Marx and his entertaining mixture of fact and fancy, although we were not always sure which was which.
