A new definition of a farm which is uniform throughout the country for purposes of the acreage allotment and soil bank pro grams, takes effect this year ac-Stabilization and Conservation Committee.

The new definition, the committee said, places emphasis on farm operation. In general, a farm is defined as:

accessible farm, wood, or rangeland under the same ownership which is operated by the same person; and

All additional farm, wood, or rangeland under different ownership which is operated by that same person provided it is nearby and easily accessible, is approxi- David Moreman, David Morris, mately equally productive, and has been operated as part of the farm for the past two years or will be so operated for two years in the future.

Under this definition, the operator of a farm means the person who is in charge of the supervision and conduct of the farming operations.

Participants in the Soil Bank program are reminded that they must not plant crops for harvest in excess of their permitted acreage




